Convention of Human Rights in Takistan

1. All persons have the right to freedom of expression, thought and opinion.
2. All persons have the right to peaceful assembly and gathering.
3. All persons shall be treated equally before the law.
4. All persons are entitled to a fair trial and treated innocent until proven guilty in a court.
5. No person shall be subject to torture, slavery or imprisonment against their free will.
6. All persons have the right own and defend private property.
7. All persons have the right to free medical care.
8. All persons have the right to freely move around the country.
9. All persons have the right to seek asylum.
10. All persons have the right to be elected for public office.

About this document:

The United Nations Convention of Human Rights in Takistan was passed by the General Assembly of the United Nations to ensure

that all citizens of Takistan share the same freedoms as other members of the United Nations. This document outlines the rights and

liberties of all the citizens and is incorporated into the Constitution of the nation of Takistan.

Peacekeepers within the region will uphold and enforce this document and its purpose in protecting all citizens.
